WOW, is all we can say.

All children in school rose to the challenge to run as many laps of the playground as possible. In the end, for all years, we had to stop them after 45 minutes. Given the opportunity, some of them would have gone on and on and on!! Definitely some marathon contenders in the making!



The results were as follows:

Preschool: 625 laps which equated to 31.25 miles or an average of 1 mile per child Reception: 383 laps which equated to 19.2 miles or an average of 1.4 miles per child Year 1: 1024 laps which equated to 51 miles or an average of 3.2 miles per child Year 2: 1426 laps which equated to 71.3 miles or an average of 2.9 miles per child Year 3: 2050 laps which equated to 64.1 miles or an average of 2 miles per child Year 4: 1167 laps which equated to 58.4 miles or an average of 2.9 miles per child

Overall: **314 miles** were run on the day (with the parents making up the extra miles) - or the equivalent of **over 12 marathons!! Phenomenal!!**

clothes which raised £52.





What are we learning in our classrooms this week?

In Literacy, we are learning how to write a list and will be listing any minibeasts we find on our hunt in the forest school area.	In Literacy, we are learning about singular and plural nouns.	In Literacy, we are going to make predictions about what is going to happen in the story of the Mousehole Cat.	In Literacy, we are practising editing and improving our own writing.	In Literacy, we are learning how paragraphs are formed.
In Numeracy, we are adding two single digit numbers together to find a total.	In Numeracy, we are learning to count in 2s, 10s and 5s.	In Numeracy, we will learn about the unit fractions: ½ and ¼	In Numeracy, we are splitting a whole into unit fractions and non- unit fractions. A unit fraction is any fraction with 1 as the numerator (on the top), such as $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ $\frac{1}{5}$.	In Numeracy, we are looking at making a whole out of tenths and hundredths.
In PE, we are learning new football skills with our coach, Trevor.	In Design and Technology, we are looking at how we get our food from farms.	In Art, we will begin to explore how to create relief sculptures in clay based on the ancient Mesopotamian artists.	In History, we are finding out about Stonehenge, which was first used as an important site at the end of the Neolithic period.	In Geography, we are looking at North America and how it differs from Europe.
