### **Reception Class Health Information**

**Health Questionnaire** - Last week, we sent to parents some information from the school nursing service on a health questionnaire. This needs to be completed online.

If your child needs any medication while away, please remember that you will need to complete an administering medication form.


### **Sharing Assemblies**
