Year 4 Production - Puss in Boots


Tickets for the Year 4 production of 'Puss in Boots' are now available for everyone to purchase.

In Literacy, we will continue to practice writing captions using our fred fingers, fingers spaces and a full stop.	In Literacy, we are revisiting the conjunctions 'and' and 'but' to extend our sentences.	In Literacy, we will be using the 'The Day the Crayons Quit' to write letters using statement, exclamation, question and command sentences.	In Literacy, we are writing a Non-Fiction report on Hinduism.	In Literacy, we conclude our Poetry Project work by writing a letter to our new middle school teacher.			
In Numeracy, we are learning about 'mapping' and will be talking about what we see on aerial maps of the local community.	In Numeracy, we are learning to count forwards and backwards to 100 in 1s and in 10s.	In Numeracy, we will consolidate our knowledge of addition and subtraction.	In Numeracy, we are solving problems involving time, including duration of events.
