## What are we learning in our classrooms this week?

We are looking at 'Little Red Riding Hood' and will be writing speech bubbles for the Wolf.	In Literacy, we will be recognising and using the conjunctions 'and' & 'but'.	In Literacy, we will be learning about different types of sentences. Using question, statement and command sentences.	In Literacy, we are planning, writing and editing a report on plants.	In Literacy, alongside our work on The Butterfly Lion, we will continue to learn about speech in writing.
In Numeracy, we will be exploring 'doubles' and learning how it means the same number added to itself.	In Numeracy, we will be comparing and ordering numbers to 20.	In Numeracy, we will be learning the two times table and related division facts.	In Numeracy, we are continuing to practise the formal written method to multiply a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.	In Numeracy we are learning about measuring in kms and finding perimeters of polygons.
In PE, we are learning how to maintain balance whilst walking a single line. We will also be practicing our one-leg and seated balances.	In Science, we will be looking at what different animals eat and using the terms carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.	In Computing, we will be looking at designing our own algorithms using the Bee-bots.	In Computing, we are using costumes to change the appearance of a "sprite" (character).	In Science, we are learning about animals, including humans, in food chains.
