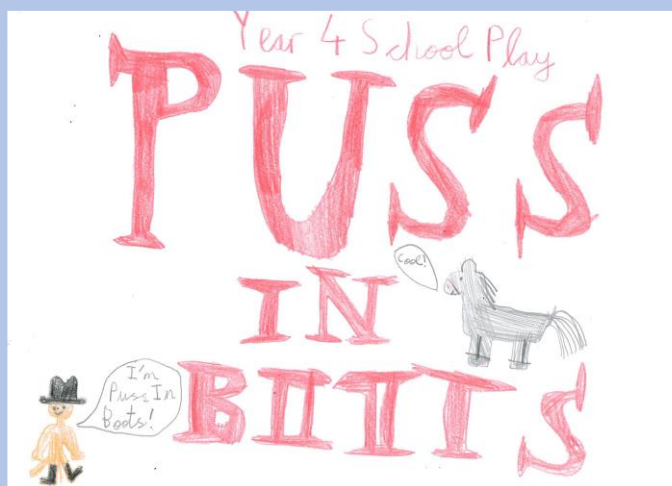
## Year 4 Production – Puss in Boots
