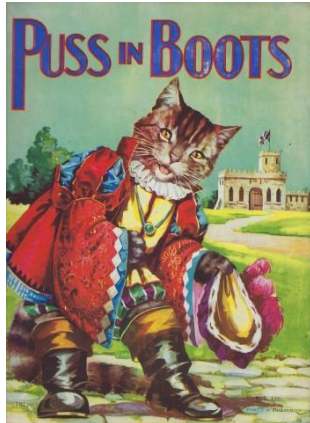

What are we learning in our classrooms this week?

In Literacy, we are focusing on using a finger space after each word in a sentence. This is preparing us for sentence writing in Year 1.	In Literacy, we will be focusing on reading real and nonsense words with the split digraph sounds: a_e, i_e, o_e and u_e in preparation for our phonics screening check next week.	In Literacy, we will be consolidating and reviewing using capital letters in our writing.	In Literacy, we are sequencing sentences that share a common theme to make paragraphs.	In Literacy, we are consolidating our learning of writing speech in paragraphs
In Numeracy, we will begin our learning on sharing and grouping numbers.	In Numeracy, we will be focusing on knowing our doubles to 10+10.	In Numeracy, we will use tally charts and tables to present data.	In Numeracy, we are counting coins and notes to find a total.	In Numeracy, we will be looking at how to interpret graphs and how to draw line graphs.
In Science, we will be looking at plants and flowers growing around the school and will begin to learn about the parts of a plant.	In Science, we will be sorting animals into herbivores, carnivores and omnivores and looking at the similarities and differences between these animals.	In Art, we will continue our work with clay to create our own relief sculptures.	In DT, we are learning about shell structures. We will explore how to join cardboard by making splits on each piece and slotting them together.	In History, we will be looking at the role of women in World War 2.
